There are a number of carpet cleaning methods available, two popular methods are:

Encapsulation: This method involves using an innovative chemical that catches dirt and bacteria in between the carpet fibres. This method is ideal for thin pile carpets and leaves the carpets dry almost instantaneously, meaning the carpets can be walked on straight away if necessary.

Extraction: Wet extraction is the most common method which uses a combination of water and chemicals that soap the fibres and vacuums away the dirt collected by the applied water. This is ideal for areas with heavy staining and thicker pile carpets.
